Undergraduate TA work (e.g. term papers, research projects) must be limited to preliminary review for the TA's intellectual benefit. Grading of such work is the responsibility of the course instructor.

## Supervision necessitates the following:

- At least 1 to 2 hour weekly group or individual meeting with course instructor.
- Explicit statement of basis for evaluation of the student's work based on standards of performance in the various areas encompassed.
- Instructor visitation and evaluation of TA led sections at least twice during the semester as well as extensive training by instructor.
